INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FLOOR BOARDGAME

There are 36 squares. Some have questions, others don't. All you need to play it is a dice. Once the students throw the dice, they just move along the board according to the number on the dice.

If they answer correctly, they carry on playing. If they don't, the next team has a turn.

Square 2: Ireland

Square 4: Portugal, Poland

Square 5: 12 stars

Square 6: France

Square 8: Yes

Square 9: Ode to Joy

Square 12: 27 countries

Square 13: Spain, Slovakia, Slovenia (2 of those)

Square 14: Athens

Square 16: 19 countries use the Euro

Square 17: Rome, capital of Italy

Square 19: In 1973

Square 20: France, Germany, Italy, Belgium, Netherlands and Luxembourg (3 of those)

Square 21: No but Switzerland is in the Schengen area.

Square 22: Slovakia

Square 24: Portugal

Square 25: Ursula Von Der Leyen, President of the European Commission

Square 26: 24 official languages in the EU, including Irish

Square 28: Freedoms of movement of people, goods, services and capital (two of those)

Square 29: The UK - Great Britain (England, Scotland and Wales left the Single Market and the Customs Union - Northern Ireland left only the Customs Union. This has generated tensions in Northern Ireland).

Square 30: Unity in Diversity

Square 32: the Euro

Square 33: Croatia and Czech republic in the EU / Canada and China outside the EU, for example.

Square 36: for example, peace - equality - rule of law - democracy - solidarity - freedom - respect for human dignity and human rights.
